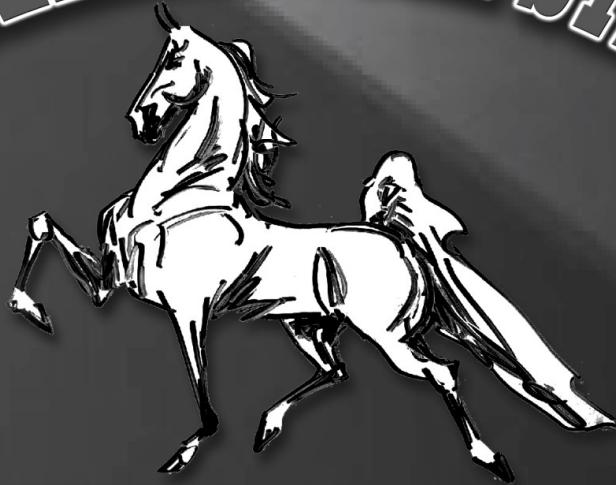

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Entries:** Closing date for entries is May 8 and an open check is acceptable for entries only. Any entries not paid in full or received after the closing date (except stake and championship classes) will be considered Post Entries. Post Entries will be accepted at \$25.00 per Horse. Show management reserves the right to refuse any and all entries or to return any money paid for stalls or entry fees without explanation or recourse to the show for liability or compensation. Returned checks will be assessed \$25.00 for each redeposit and \$50.00 if a check cannot be presented to a bank as a cash item.
- 2. Stalls:** Stalls will be available from Sunday, June 6 through Sunday, June 14 at \$125.00 per stall (temporary stabling facilities need to be vacated by 2:00 P.M.). If you plan to arrive prior to Sunday, June 6, or need to stay over past Sunday, June 13 at 2:00 P.M., please call Craig Thompson (423-506-3849). All stall fees must be paid in full by the closing date May 8 (an open check is acceptable). Stall fees are not refundable. Stalls will be assigned by the show management to most efficiently use available stalls.
- 3. Tent Damage:** Tents (including the valance) must not be damaged or altered in any manner (i.e.: cut, punctured, rods, or tie chains adjusted or removed, etc.). Damages will be charged to the exhibitor occupying the damaged portion of the tent.
- 4. Bedding:** Bedding will be available at \$8.00 per bag directly from the show office and may be ordered in advance on the entry form and returned along with your stall reservations and/or entries. Orders needed prior to Sunday, June 6, must be requested no later than 4:00 P.M. on Thursday, June 3 by calling Craig Thompson (423-506-3849). Beginning on Sunday, June 6, all orders must be in the show office prior to 10:00 A.M. for same day delivery. No first bedding will be furnished.
- 5. Payment:** Exhibitors wishing to pay their show account individually must complete a separate entry form to set up a separate account and furnish their Social Security Number or Tax ID Number.
- 6. Refunds:** Entry fee refunds requested prior to the entry closing date (May 8) will be made in full (less the non-refundable office fee of \$15.00 per horse). After the closing date, entry fees will be refunded only with a veterinarian's certificate. Exhibitors may enter other classes, but no entry fee will otherwise be refunded. Stall fees are not refundable.
- 7. Scratches:** Scratches must be made in the show office by 9:00 A.M. for morning performances and during regular office hours for evening performances.
- 8. Office Hours:** The show office will be open from 9:00 A.M. to 5:30 P.M. on Monday (June 7). Packets will be available by 1:00 P.M. Tuesday, the office will open at 9:00 A.M. Office Hours will be posted for the remainder of the show.
- 9. Box Seats and Ringside Parking:** Contact Beth Snider at 502-314-7960 to reserve a Box Seat or Ringside Parking Spot. Box Seats (6 seats) and Ringside Parking Spots cost \$150.00.
- 10. Camper Hook-Up:** Limited Camper sites are available on the show grounds for \$35.00 per day. Please make reservations by calling Craig Thompson (423-506-3849). The Chattanooga/North Cleveland KOA Campgrounds are located at 648 Pleasant Grove Road, Cleveland, Tennessee 37353 (one mile down the road from the show grounds). For reservations call 800-562-9739.
- 11. Qualifying Classes will be Split as Follows:** Academy classes will be split at 12, ten and under classes will be split at 12, driving classes will be split at 15, junior exhibitor classes will be split at 15, and all other classes will be split at 25.
- 12. Request for Holds:** For the benefit of all exhibitors, please place your hold request in advance of each session. Emergency holds will be accepted by the Paddock Master.
- 13. Negative Coggins:** A negative coggins must accompany each horse (current within one year of the show). Proof will be required when picking up back numbers. If possible, please send a copy with entries to expedite office time.

14. Horse Soundness: All horses and ponies must be serviceably sound. In case of suspected unsoundness, the judge may, if he so desired, have the horse or pony examined by the show veterinarian, and his decision will be final. No exhibitor may use a Veterinarian's Statement to contradict the judge's decision.

15. Dress: All riders, drivers, attendants, and grooms shall be neatly and appropriately dressed upon entering the ring.

16. Ring Procedures: The gate to the show ring will remain open two minutes after the first horse enters the ring, after which the gate will be closed. Any exhibitor not in the ring by that time will not be admitted. Please cooperate by being on time. Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls over that system must be considered a courtesy. Therefore, no protest will be upheld, nor will any section be changed due to a PA malfunction.

17. Discipline: Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judge, or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, driver, or attendant shall be grounds to disqualify the horse. The owner shall forfeit the entry fee and other fees. In the case of any horse being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in that class shall take the prize that has been awarded to such disqualified horse.

18. Show Ring: No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitors and those having official or requested duties to perform.

19. Warm Up and Show Ring Courtesy: Exhibitors and trainers are cautioned as to their conduct in and around the show and warm up rings, especially in respect to schooling of horses. Items such as Balloons, Helium Items, Chains, Tape Measures, Blow Horns, Aerosol Cans, Split Bamboo Poles, Fireworks, Fire Extinguishers, or Whips Longer than six Feet that would alter or disturb the performance of a horse are prohibited.

20. Protests: Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the rules stated herein, the same shall be referred to the show management whose decision will be final. The show management will act as steward when any rule needs to be reviewed for clarification. In the event of a protest, the fee of \$100.00 will be payable to the Cleveland Tri-State Charity Horse Show and is not refundable.

21. Liability: The Cleveland Tri-State Charity Horse Show and the Tri-State Exhibition Center, Inc. will not be responsible for any accident, theft, damage, or injury occurring at the facility. *Warning: Under Tennessee law, an equine activity sponsor or professional shall not be liable for an injury to, or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, title 44, chapter 20, part 101.*

22. Parking: All trucks, vans, trailers, and RVs, after unloading, must park in designated parking areas. All aisles and roadways around barns or tents must be kept open at all times. No recreational vehicles or trailers will be allowed to hook up to electrical outlets in the stall areas.

23. Pets: All pets on the grounds must be on a leash and under control at all times.

24. Stable Area: Gas, electric, or propane heaters; propane tanks; and hot plates are prohibited in the stable area. All electrical extension cords must be 12 gauge, 3 wire and prong negative type.

25. Manure: All manure and used shavings removed from the stalls or trailers must be placed in the manure pit or specified areas.

26. Barn Aisles and Doorways: Barn aisles and doorways must remain clear at all times. Stall guards on each stall must be closed and latched when unattended.

27. Smoking: No smoking is allowed in any building, restroom, or stable areas.

28. Jackpot and UPHA Classic Prize Money: Prize money will be mailed to the party of record within 30 days after the show's end. Any checks not cashed by September 1, 2020, will be forfeited to the show.

PRIZE MONEY

All classes will be placed to 8th place except the Saddle & Bridle classes, the AHHS Youth Medallion classes, and the UPHA Classic classes which will be placed to 6th. In the Academy Lead Line Walk Only--Any Age Rider class, everyone will receive a Blue Ribbon.

\$1,000.00 Jackpot Classes—Entry Fee \$110.00

50% of the entry fee in Jackpot classes will be added to the \$1,000.00 Prize Money and will be paid out as follows: 1st--35%, 2nd--20%, 3rd--15%, 4th--10%, 5th--10%, 6th--10%, 7th--Ribbon, and 8th--Ribbon.

\$250.00 UPHA Classic Classes—Entry Fee \$100.00

A non-refundable eligibility fee of \$100.00 paid to the UPHA Office postmarked on or before April 1st of each year. After April 1st, the eligibility fee becomes \$150.00 per horse. Payment of the eligibility fee will be made payable to UPHA, Inc. in the name of the entered horse or pony and will make that animal eligible to compete in any and all UPHA Classics classes held that year. Eligibility remains with the animal throughout the year should transfer of ownership occur. Eligibility fees collected will be used as prize money in the UPHA Classic Grand Championships.

The entry fee for each qualifying class is \$100.00 and is made in two payments. The first payment, the declaration fee, is \$50.00 and must be made by the entry closing date of the particular horse show. The second payment, the starting fee, is also \$50.00 and is due 24 hours prior to the class, whenever practical. All entry fees, or partial entry fees, are added to the total purse of the class.

A horse may be shown in one or more Classics; however, the declaration and starting fees must be paid for each Classic in which it will be shown. This also applies to showing in more than one division. Fees are non-refundable in all situations.

\$150.00 is deducted from the total with \$50.00 going to fourth, fifth, and sixth places. Of the balance, 50% is paid to first place, 30% to second place, and 20% to third place. If there were only 2 entries, the total prize money would be split 60% and 40%. If only 3 entries show, the original percentages would apply, without the \$150.00 deduction. In case of only one entry, that entry would receive 100% of the total.

To be shown with a full mane and tail at a walk, trot, and canter.

The Saddlebred Three-Gaited Park Pleasure Horse should be stylish with finish and quality and well mannered. Open to mares and geldings shown by professionals and amateurs, the performance should be animated and graceful at all gaits. Horses shown in any class of this division are ineligible to show in the Saddlebred Performance or the Saddlebred Pleasure Divisions at the same show. To be shown with a full mane and tail at a flat walk, trot and canter. All entries in the division are required to back. Judged 75% on manners, performance, presence and quality; 25% on total conformation.

American Saddlebred-type ponies are restricted to mares and geldings not to exceed 14.2 hands ridden by a Junior Exhibitor. Measurement cards must be available on request or pony should be available for measurement should any question arise.
